Simply stated, discipleship is making Christ the Lord of One's life.*

- **Experiencing God: Knowing and Doing the Will of God** by Henry Blackaby.
This study helps Christians develop an intimate relationship with God so they can hear when God is speaking.
- **Parenting by Grace** by Dixie Ruth Crase & Arthur A Criscoe (10 Sessions)
A study on the art of parenting from a biblical basis.
- **Experiencing God as Couples** by Henry Blackaby (8 Sessions) focuses on leading married couples to experience God's presence in a way that will last a lifetime by letting Him have His way in their marriage.
- **Foundations of Faith: The Doctrines Baptists Believe** by Roy Edgeman (6 sessions) Focuses on the foundation of christianity with emphasis on the Baptist beliefs.
- **A 40 Day Experience: Reality 7 Truths from Experiencing God** by Henry Blackaby (7 sessions) This study will strengthen your relationship with other believers and, ultimately, with God. Because only when you are fully aware of God's presence can you know and do His will. That's Reality!
- **Pray In Faith (Growing Disciples Series)** by T. W. Hunt & Claude King (6 sessions) Participants learn to hear from God in prayer, respond to God, and join His work.
- **Disciples Prayer Life: Walking in Fellowship with God** by T. W. Hunt & Catherine Walker (13 sessions) Helps adults learn to pray experientially – based on prayers of the Bible. Helps to strengthen your prayer life.

WOMEN STUDIES:

- **Lord, Teach Me to Pray: Practicing a Powerful Pattern of Prayer** by Kay Arthur (5 sessions) Learn what the Lord's prayer teaches us about effective prayer and how to put into practice its timeless principles. (for men also)

- **One in a Million** by Priscilla Shirer (7 sessions) An indepth study of the Israelites journey through the wilderness. It is an opportunity for you to experience your deliverance from strongholds, to conquer your wilderness living, and to claim your God-given inheritance.
- **Esther: It's Tough Being a Women** by Beth Moore (10 sessions) looks at the story of Esther as a profile in courage and contains many modern parallels for today's woman. Going up against heavyweights bent on her destruction, Esther trusted God and landed a blow that saved her people. Esther's destiny can be yours as you know more deeply the God who is in your corner.
- **Breaking Free: The Journey, The Stories** by Beth Moore (11 sessions) leads you through a study of the Scriptures to discover the transforming power of Christian freedom. Beth shows that anything that hinders us from the benefits of knowing God is bondage.
- **A Woman's Heart: God's Dwelling Place** by Beth Moore (10 or 11 week session) Discover the parallels of the Tabernacle's building and your life as a chosen vessel of God.
- **Anointed, Transformed, Redeemed: A Study of David** by Beth Moore, Priscilla Shirer and Kay Arthur. Each segment focuses on the life of David at a different stage of his life. This study could include men.
- **The Patriarchs: Encountering the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob** by Beth Moore (11 sessions) Indepth study of God's remarkable pursuit of relationship and to the unfolding of His earthly plan: that one nation – and ultimately one man—all people on earth will be blessed. Explore concepts such as blessing, covenant, and promise, and the bearing each has on a New Testament believer's life today.

YOUTH STUDIES:

- **Experiencing God: Youth Edition** by Henry Blackaby and Claude King (9 sessions) Learn to hear God speaking, find out how he is speaking, find out where God is working and join Him, and experience God doing what only He can do.
- **Transformed for His Purpose: the Student God Uses** by Henry and Tom Blackaby (6 sessions) Helps teenagers come to understand the way God molds the character of the person He chooses to use for His purpose.
